**MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF SANCREED PARISH COUNCIL HELD AT MARY WILLIAMS HALL, SANCREED, ON 19<sup>TH</sup> FEBRUARY 2019 AT 7.30PM**

**COUNCILLORS PRESENT**

**19-100. APOLOGIES**

Apologies were accepted from Councillors Mr Ivor James and Mr James Maddern.

**19-101. DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST**

There were no declarations of interest.

**19-102. PUBLIC SPEAKING**

No member of the public wished to speak.

**19-103. POLICE**

No crimes had been reported in December.

**19-104. MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING**

The minutes of the meeting held on 15<sup>th</sup> January 2019 having been previously circulated, it was resolved that they were a true and correct record and were signed.

**19-105. MEMORIAL FOR COUNCILLOR BILL MADDERN**

The family of the late Councillor Bill Maddern had expressed the feelings that a bench would be ideal. Further discussions followed on the site, the suggestion of picnic seating on The Glebe and the possibility of it being made from stone to lessen the likelihood of it being stolen. It was decided to postpone any decision until the following meeting.

**19-106. VACANCY**

Councillors were informed that the notices had been placed in Down Your Way, on the website and noticeboards with a closing date of Friday 8<sup>th</sup> March 2019. One enquiry had been received to date but no applications. Applicants would be interviewed at the next meeting.

**19-107. FOOTPATHS AND HIGHWAYS**

- It was reported that the bridleway sign at Trevorrian had been re-instated.
- A complaint had been received that the footpaths across Trenuggo were not being cut by the Parish Council and that the bridleway running in a northerly direction towards Trevorrian required trimming. On checking the maps it was established that no paths crossing that land nor the bridleway were on the LMP cutting regime so it was decided to write to the complainant explaining this, pointing out that it is the responsibility of the landowner or tenant to keep the paths and stiles in safe condition and that the landowner, Bolitho Estates, should be approached about the bridleway.
- Cornwall Council were offering the same grant as the previous year, £2730.47, to cut the LMP paths. It was agreed to accept this offer.
- Councillor Mrs Hawkins had sent information about A3071 saying that the surveyors had been out and that she had been informed by Mike Peters (Cormac) that they would be looking at speed management and footways, where possible. The plans would be available in April.
